



## WEEK 7 DISCUSSION GUIDE

### MESSAGE NOTES:

1. Andy said that the most important event recorded in the Bible is the resurrection. He said with no resurrection, there would be no Bible. How do you respond to that? What would be the result if we lose sight of that fact?
2. Have you ever thought or known someone who thought that the resurrection was fabricated by the followers of Jesus years after his death?
3. Share any SOAP Journal entries you have from 1 Corinthians 15:1-34.
4. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-6. Where in these verses do you find the “creed” that Andy explained? (Christ died for our sins and was buried; He rose from the dead and was seen.)
5. Could someone become a Christian with only that simple creed? How might that happen?
6. Whom did Jesus appear to? Why was that so important?
7. How does the simple statement of the gospel in this creed remind us that this good news is for everyone?
8. How could you have peace with God without being at peace with everything in the Bible? Have you come to the place where you are at peace with God?

**Bottom Line:** We can have peace with God without having peace with everything in the Bible.

# SOAP JOURNAL EXERCISE

*Read: For a summer reading list, download the YouVersion app and find the First Steps Reading Plan.*

**S – Scripture** – Choose one verse from the scripture above and hand write it below.

**O – Observation** – Describe in your own words what you think the verse is saying. Explore words and phrases and try to put down what you “see” in this verse. You can even re-write the verse in your own words.

**A – Application** – Write down what you should do because of what this verse says. It may be something you need to keep doing, stop doing, or start new. Make it as detailed and specific as possible.

**P – Prayer** – Write a prayer thanking God for speaking to you, and ask him to help you focus on what he has said and what you should do.
