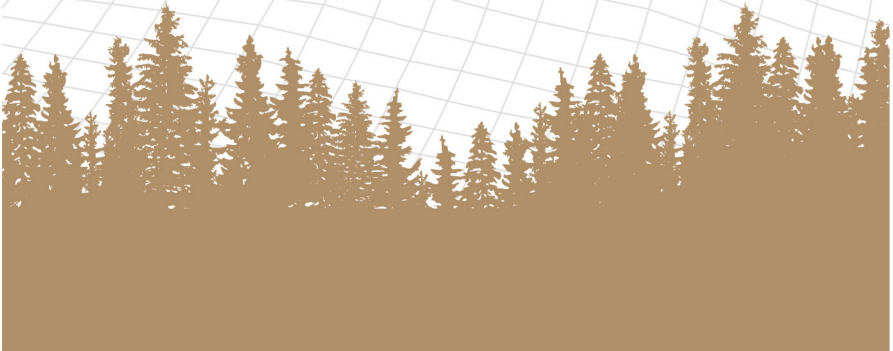


12. How has this course prepared and motivated you to be able to tell your part of the story, your part of The Epic Adventure?
